How to APPLY

Participants in the China Global Education Fellowship must:

1. Be a native-level English speaker
2. Be TEFL or TESOL certified* OR have at least 2 years of post-college work experience
3. Have a BA/BS degree by June 1st
4. Be between the ages of 21 and 60
5. Be highly flexible, mature, and have a genuine interest in teaching English
6. Be committed to improving education and learning globally, and be excited about the opportunity to gain international professional experience

*Applicants for the China Program can get TEFL certified through a modified WorldTeach TEFL Certification Program during pre-departure. The deadline to complete the online certification is May 15th, 2017.

About the FELLOWSHIP

The WorldTeach Global Education Fellowship focuses on the intersection of globalization and learning in the 21st century.

As a China Global Education Fellow, you will live in and experience a country that makes up 20 percent of the world's population and is on the brink of becoming the world's largest economy. What does this mean for the future of global trade and the global workplace? In what ways does China's modernization impact Chinese society overall and its next generation of entrepreneurs, teachers, and professionals? How are traditional cultures and norms being impacted during this period of rapid industrialization and urbanization?

These and other questions related to emerging trends in globalization and learning will be explored during your fellowship. Serving as a full time teacher in a local school in Hunan Province, you will also take part in experiential reflection projects, either individually or in collaboration with other Fellows.

As a China Global Education Fellow you will develop highly coveted 21st century skills and Chinese cultural expertise, making you more competitive in the global marketplace. To enhance Chinese language acquisition, you have the option of enrolling in the **Mandarin Language track** providing formal weekly lessons (optional w/ an additional \$950 fee). In return, you will serve as a teacher and role model for high school and middle school students who, themselves, are facing a highly competitive educational and employment market.

Placements for your fellowship take you to a town or city in the Hunan province. With a population of more than 65 million people, Hunan Province includes the large and vibrant capital city of Changsha as well as smaller, but still urban, town centers.
